Spring 2005

UI Campus votes against a proposal for a P&S Union

August 2005

UI Staff Council sent a proposal to UI Administration outlining proposed goals and procedures to implement a vehicle of Shared Governance on Campus.

February 2006

UI President David Skorton and Provost Michael Hogan send a charge to the campus colleges to support an initiative to develop the structure for goals and practices of Shared Governance in each college.

Spring 2006

Dean Damico, College of Education appoints Chris Annicella to chair a steering committee to develop a proposal for Shared Governance in the College of Education with interested P&S/Merit Exempt staff.

Spring/Summer 2006

College of Education Shared Governance Steering Committee met throughout the spring and summer of 2006 to develop a proposal for the College of Education Dean to consider regarding the implementation of a Shared Governance in the college.

September 29, 2006

The **College of Education's Steering Committee for Shared Governance** forwarded a proposal to Dean Sandy Damico, College of Education, Goals and Procedures for a Professional, Scientific and Merit-Exempt Shared Governance Council.

January 30, 2007

The first formal meeting of the College of Education Staff Council met.

October 2008

College of Education Staff Council is asked to help promote/roll out UI Working at Iowa Survey

November 2008

College of Education Staff Council holds an ALL college kick-off event in Jones Commons for the UI Working at Iowa Survey. Pat Kenner facilitated.

November 2009

College of Education receives UI Working at Iowa Survey Results

February 2010

College of Education Focus Groups on UI Working at Iowa Survey

Summer 2010

College of Education Staff Council prepares a Focus Group report and forwards to College of Education Dean. College of Education Staff Council met with College of Education Dean to review the Working at Iowa Focus Group Report. It was decided an Ad-hoc committee should review all materials related to the survey and focus groups.

Fall 2010

College of Education Staff Council develops an Ad-Hoc group to address the findings of the UI Working at Iowa Survey and College of Education Focus groups relating to the UI Working at Iowa Survey.

Fall 2010

College of Education Ad-Hoc Committee begins meetings.

Fall 2011

College of Education Ad-Hoc Committee presents a DRAFT report to College of Education Staff Council.

Spring 2012

College of Education Staff Council present the Ad-Hoc Committee's report to Dean of the College of Education

February 2012

College of Education Staff Council and WAI Ad-Hoc Committee discuss report with Dean Crocco
