ADMISSION PROCEDURES

Application forms for admission to the teacher education program may be obtained from the Office of Student Services, N310 LC. Applications may be submitted by March 15 or October 15. A limited number of applicants are accepted into the art teacher education program, so meeting the minimum requirements listed below does not ensure admission. Other criteria relevant to teaching success are also considered.

MINIMUM ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

1. A University of Iowa g.p.a. and cumulative g.p.a. of 2.70 at the time of admission to this program.
2. Completion of at least 33 semester hours of college credit.
3. Twelve (12) semester hours of Art and Art History courses completed with a minimum g.p.a. of 3.00.
4. Completion of a 10-hour volunteer practicum in a K-12 classroom setting.
5. Completion of the Praxis I exam.

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

1. Completion of all professional education requirements for teaching art in grade 7-12 and for teaching art in grades K-6. The K-6 professional education requirements are for art teaching only and do not prepare candidates for general elementary teaching.
2. Completion of an art teaching major as defined by the College of Liberal Arts' School of Art and Art History. This must include a minimum of 38 semester hours in art course work in the teaching area as described.
3. Maintenance of a University of Iowa g.p.a. and cumulative g.p.a. of 2.70 on all course work.
4. Must have a cumulative g.p.a. of 2.70 on all course work and a 3.00 g.p.a. on all course work in Art and Art History at the time of registration for student teaching and at the time of recommendation for licensure.
5. Approval by the designated College of Education advisor of all transfer credit or substitutions of courses for requirements listed.
6. At the time of application for student teaching, a completed copy of this program guide signed by the College of Education advisor should be attached to the student teaching application.
7. Student must complete a minimum of 20 semester hours at this institution for The University of Iowa to recommend for licensure.
8. Completion of one college-level mathematics course (excluding 22M:1/2/3)
